## DICHOTOMOUS KEY RULES

## Some Key Ideas in Dichotomous Key Construction

- 1. Use <u>definitive</u> characteristics to categorize your organism. Remember, it's THIS or NOT THIS.
- 2. Use characteristics which can be directly observed.
- 3. DO NOT use vague terms such as "big" and "small."
- 4. Remember, each question you ask will separate your organisms into TWO categories. (This or NOT this.) \*\*Remember our office supply example from class. We started with Pink or NOT Pink.
- 5. When creating your key, your dichotomous questions should equal one less than the organisms you're classifying. For example, if you are classifying 5 organisms, your key should have 4 questions, with 2 (dichotomous) answers (a & b).
