1. What is the function of the immune system?	1. The Immune system: a. protects the body against pathogens such as virus and bacteria b. Uses cells and tissues that recognize and attack foreign bodies
2. What are the parts of the immune system?	2. The immune system has no real organs but is made up of: a. Microphages - engulfs pathogens and other material b. T-cell - a cell that coordinates and attacks infected cells c. B cell - a white blood cell that makes antibodies d. Antibody - a protein made by B cells and binds to a specific antigen (antigens stimulate an immune response)
3. Where is the immune system located?	3. The immune system is not located in a specific area of the body but is located everywhere inside the body.
